On site entries if space allows with permission. Please email the secretary before coming to the site.** ABOUT RETURNED CHECKS: DRMarketing will not return checks for entries that are not accepted, or entries cancelled by the competitor before the closing date and before the check has been deposited. We shred all unused checks. All entries must be accompanied with payment to be valid. A returned check is not a valid entry. A Returned Check for insufficient funds will be charged an additional \$30 fee.

This will be a CONCURRENT event using a BLOCK schedule. NO RUN ORDER! A time block will be assigned. An email explaining the process will be sent out prior to the event.

Fast CAT events are open to all dogs One yr. of age or older & that are registered with the AKC, dogs granted a Purebred Alternative Listing (PAL) number and dogs enrolled in the Canine Partners program. Dogs with breed disqualifications and monorchid/cryptorchid dogs are eligible to participate.

If your mix-breed dog needs an AKC Canine Partner number information is below, pay by credit card and receive your registration number instantly. Your dog MUST BE spayed or neutered to receive a Canine Partner number!

Hours

Grounds are available a half hour prior to event hours. Event hours are usually 8:00AM-5:00PM or until all runs are completed. **It is the responsibility of each entrant to be ready with catcher & releaser when they are called to the line.**

Collar Rules: Dogs may run without a collar or wear any type of collar except choker collars, electronic training collars, or head collars. Collars should be snug. **Hanging tags pose a safety concern and it is suggested they be taped or removed.** Dogs may run with an approved AKC muzzle if desired. Clips or rubber bands may be used to keep long hair from the dog's field of vision.

No Open toe shoes or bare feet allowed anywhere on the course!

Check in & Inspection.

Check in/Inspection starts 15 minutes prior to the beginning of the event & at each time block throughout the event. Every dog must pass an inspection before each run. Dogs who miss their time block will be skipped. If you do not check in within one hour prior to the end of the event closing, we will assume you are absent. No refunds for absent dogs. At inspection, all dogs will be checked for lameness, and all female dogs will be checked that they are not in season. Any unfit dog will be excused with entry refunded by policy listed in refunds. Bitches known to be in season are not to be brought to the test.

Refunds!

You may pull out of the event prior to closing date/time for a refund for any reason but if entry was paid online a \$3.50 service fee per refunded entry run will be charged. Mail in checks will be shredded or if deposited, a check will be mailed to you minus a \$5 processing fee. After closing only Bitches in season and lame dogs will be handled using the same refund policy. There will be no refund after closing for any other reason, including illness to humans.

Prizes

A flat blue ribbon for a passing qualifying run.
Rosettes for completing titles BCAT, DCAT or FCAT, as available.
title by circling on the bottom of the entry form.

What is the Fast CAT?

1. Fast CAT is a timed straight 100-yard dash for dogs.
2. Dogs are held at the start line, and the coursing lure is activated, prompting the dog to follow chasing it to the finish line and into a catch pen. The course is completely fenced, and dogs are run individually.
3. Dogs are timed when they complete the 100-yard dash. The time is converted to Miles Per Hour (MPH) by using formula $204.545/\text{time}$
4. Based on the dog's size at the withers a handicap is applied. and points are earned:
 - 18" or greater = Handicap is 1.0
 - 12" up to less than 18" = Handicap is 1.5.
 - Under 12" = Handicap is 2.0.

5. FORMULA: MPH X HANDICAP = POINTS

6. Titles are earned at specific point levels.
BCAT = 150 points, DCAT = 500 points, FCAT = 1,000 points
FCAT# = Each additional 500 points

***AKC RULES; Handlers are not allowed to run on course with a dog or prior to their run. Handlers are not to entice the dog through the course with items other than the lure. NO mechanical devices, including whistles, horns, etc., NO toys including the waving of objects to lure the dog to the finish line. You MAY CHEER and use the dog's name. Food or toys can only be shown after the dog crosses the finish line to help catch the dog.**

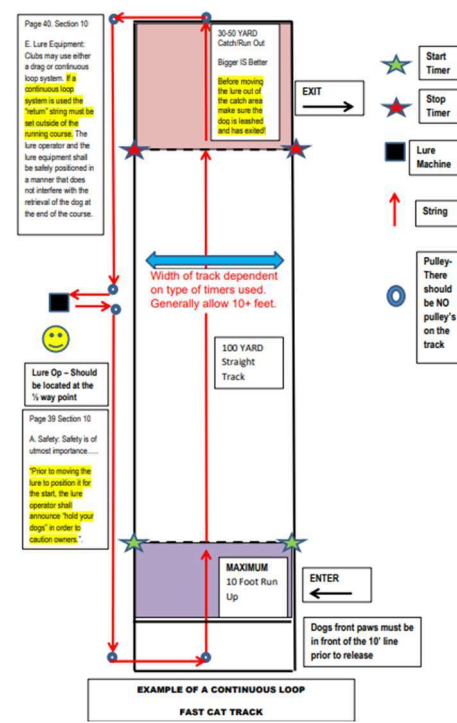

Event Information

Dogs should be warmed up before and cooled down after running.

- ALL DOGS RUN AT OWNER'S SOLE RISK
- All entries must be 12 months of age or older on the day of the test.
- All AKC rules regarding sportsmanship and conduct apply.
- These events will be in the rain. Please plan accordingly.
- **No entry fees will be refunded** if the event cannot be started or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club.
- It is suggested that Junior handlers & children handling a dog on course, be able to fully control the dog without assistance.

- The show grounds are not completely fenced. The FAST CAT course will be fenced with snow fencing and or mesh fencing material.
- Dogs must be on lead or crated unless they are running.
- You are responsible for controlling your dog(s) and children.
- Each dog requires an individual entry form for each event it is entered.
- The Hunt-master handles field safety and therefore he/she is in complete charge of all dogs and handlers on the field. He/She has the authority to stop the lure in any potentially dangerous situation and signal the handler to retrieve the dog on the course.
- People exhibiting conduct detrimental to the AKC, dog(s) or person(s) will be asked to leave the event site by the Field Committee. They may be disciplined by the AKC, and **entry fees will not be refunded**.
- The event-hosting club, its agents, members, representatives, volunteers, etc., assume no liability or responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children or spectators before, during, or after this event.
- **The Catch pen depth will be determined by the site. A minimum of 50 yds is standard but usually a 60 yd plus measurement is used.**
- A continuous loop course will be used as in the AKC diagram below.
