

Guidelines for Membership Applicants

- 1. All prospective members must have attended 2 sessions of classes and attended 2 General Membership meetings prior to being considered for membership. These meetings are generally held on the third Friday of each month, September to June. Please contact the Membership Chairperson or your class instructor for dates and times.
- 2. Fill out the application completely. Make sure to obtain all the needed signatures. Members are expected to work for the club, so you must also fill out the volunteer checklist attached to this application. If you have any questions about what each job entails, please contact the Membership Chairperson or your class instructor.
